(Due March 31)

A quick and simple application — no essay required.

[National Catholic College Admissions Association
First-Year Scholarship](#) (Due April 1)

Available to students enrolling at a Catholic college or university as a first-year student.

[Colleges That Change Lives \(CTCL\) Scholarship](#)
(Part 1 Due March 15 | Part 2 Due April 10)

This \$6,000 scholarship is for students who have been accepted to + plan to enroll at a CTCL member school.

STEM-Focused Scholarships

[Hagan Scholarship](#) (Due March 15)

A nationwide scholarship for high-achieving students with financial need. This award can provide substantial funding over multiple years of college.

[Shell Oil Company High School Senior Scholarship](#)
(Due March 15)

For students planning to pursue degrees in STEM-related fields, especially those interested in energy and technology careers.

[Society of Women Engineers Emerging First-Year
Scholars](#) (Due March 31)

Supports women entering engineering or computer science programs.

[BHW Women in STEM Scholarship](#) (Due April 15)

For women pursuing undergraduate or graduate STEM degrees. Requires a short essay submission.

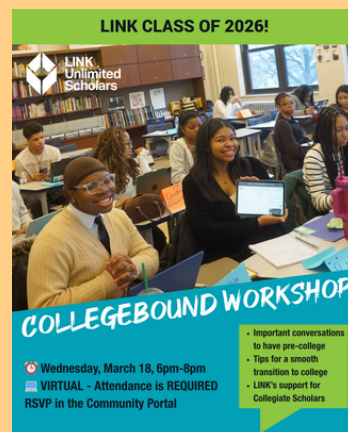
